

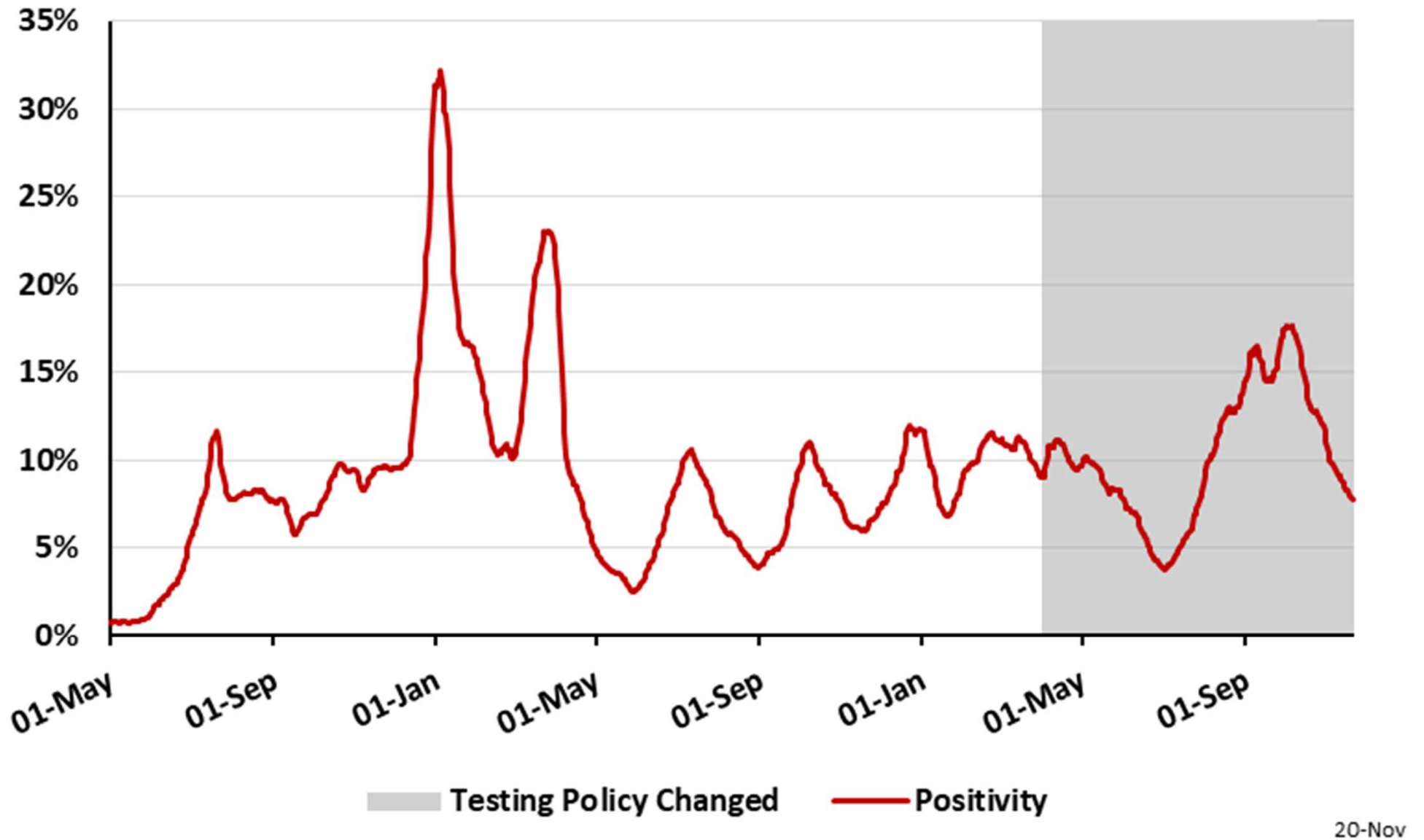

Daily Test Positivity Rate for England: May 1, 2022 – Nov 20, 2023

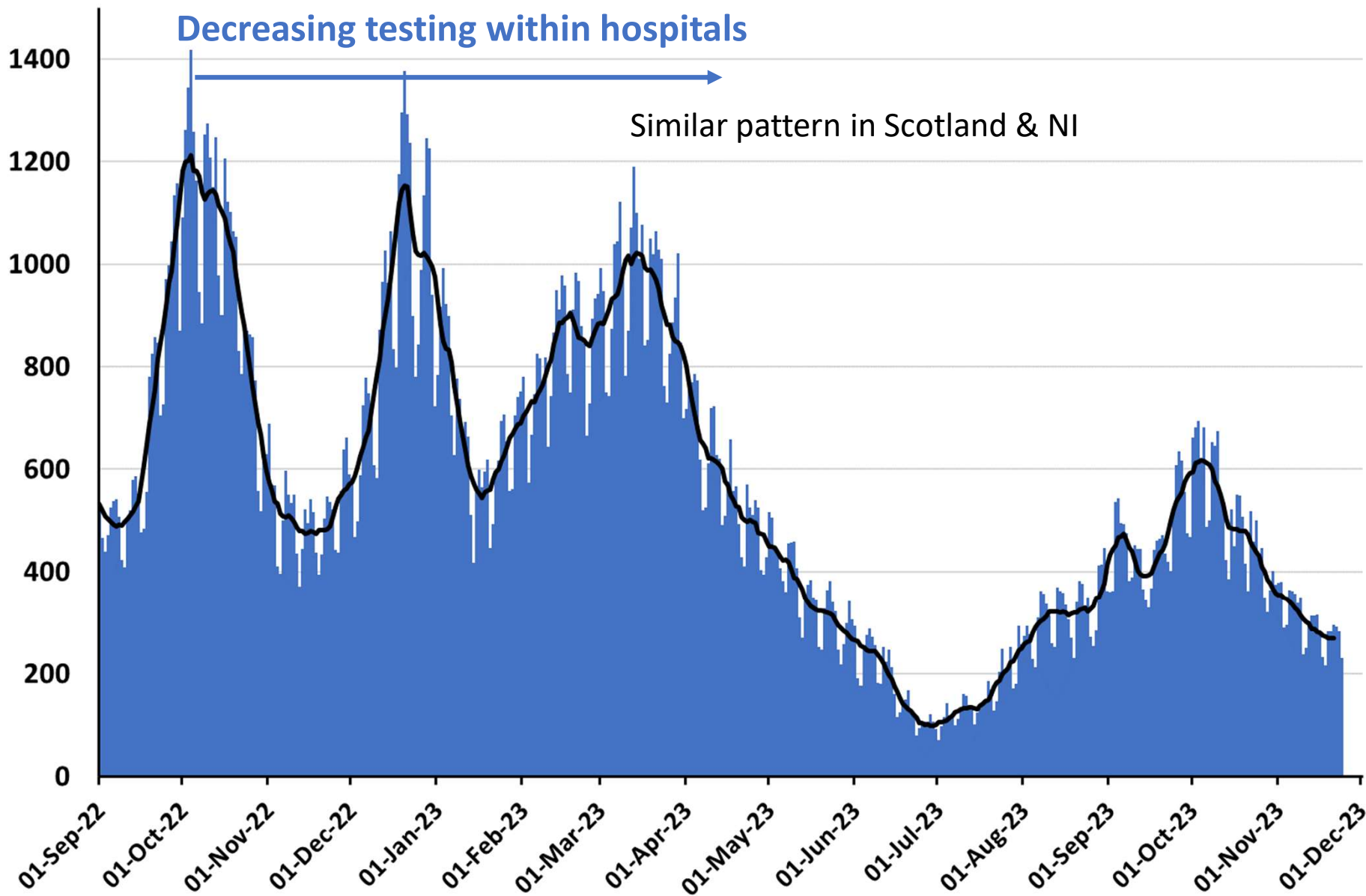

Number of daily hospital admissions with Covid in England Sept 2022 to 24 Nov 2023

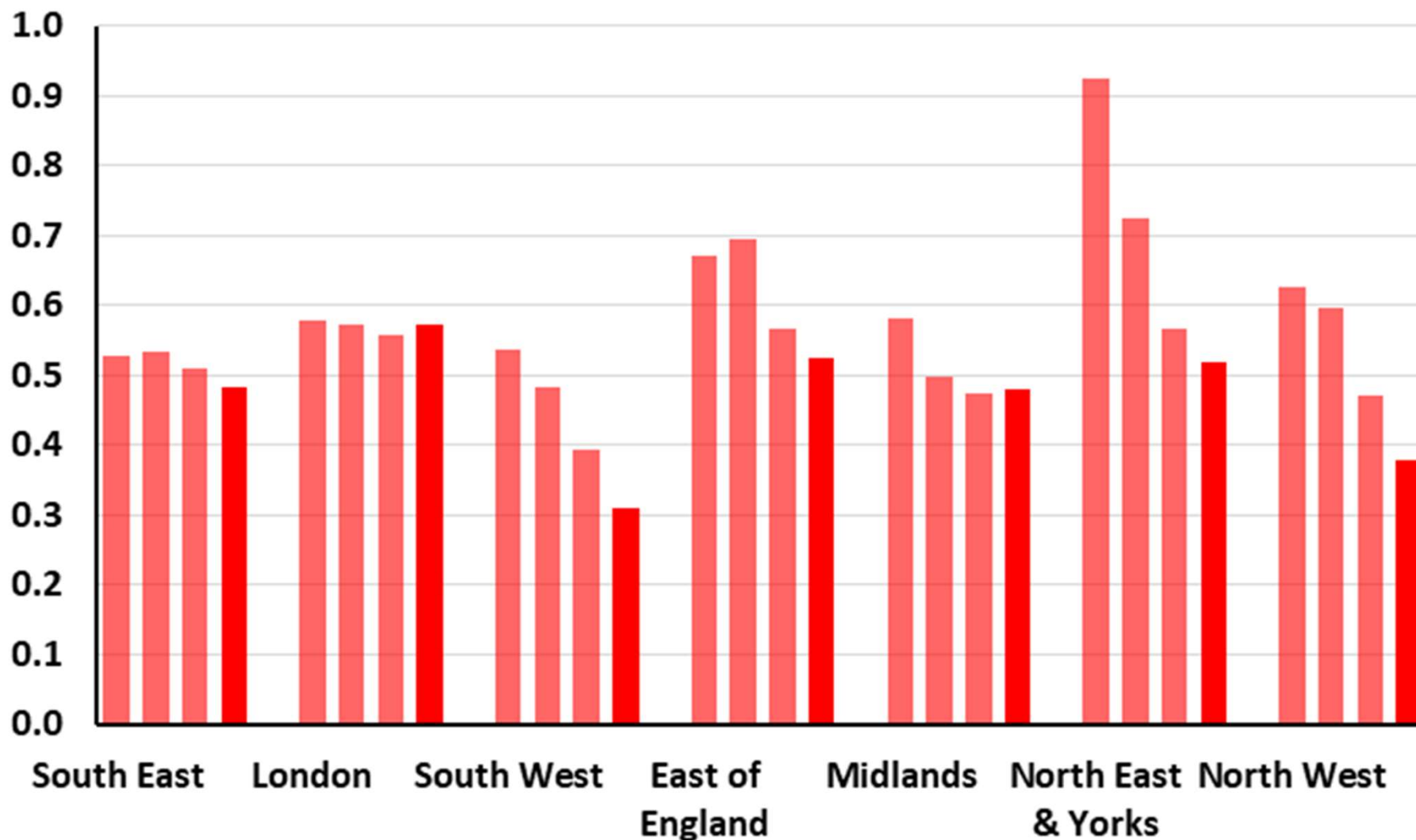

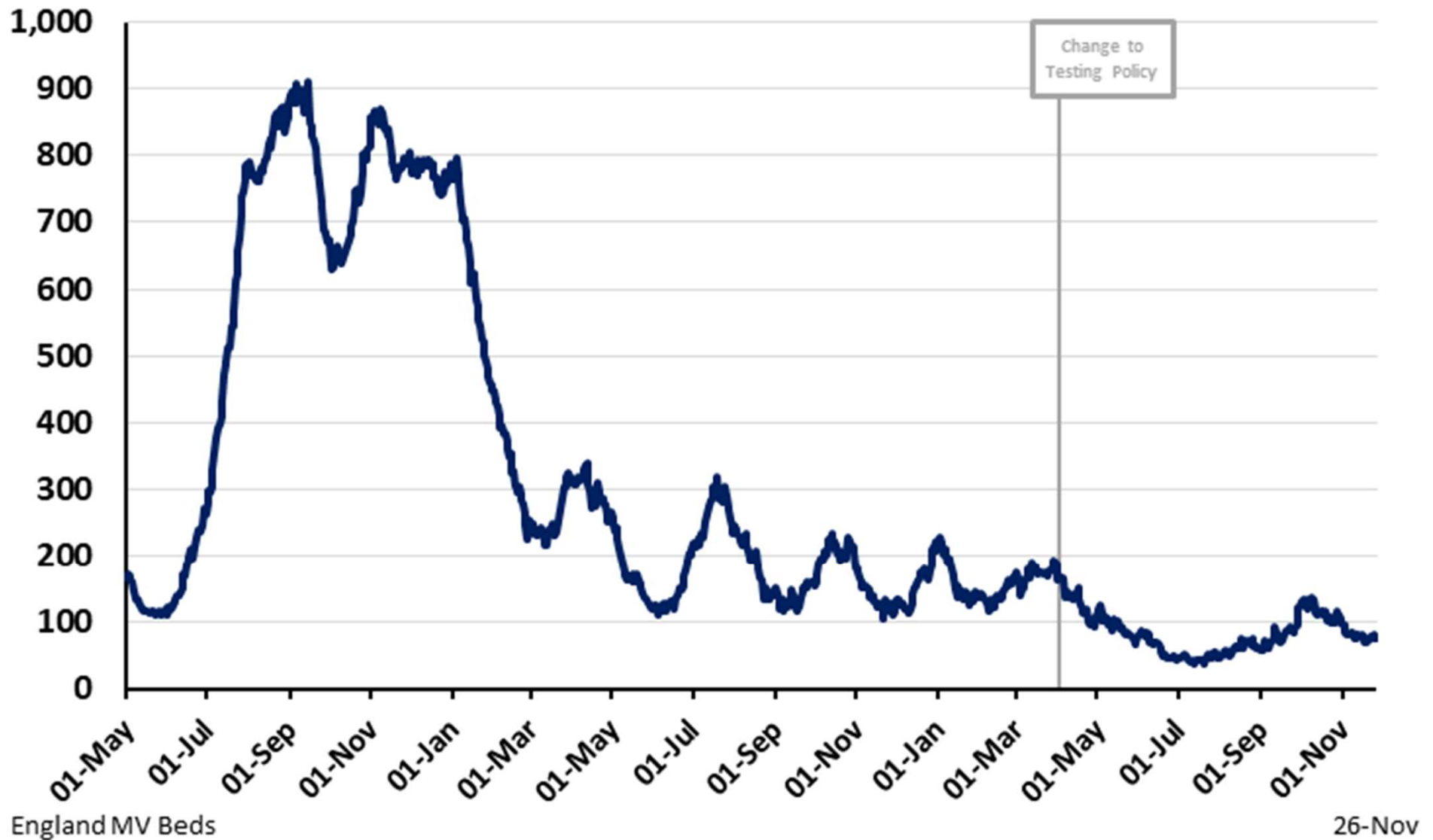

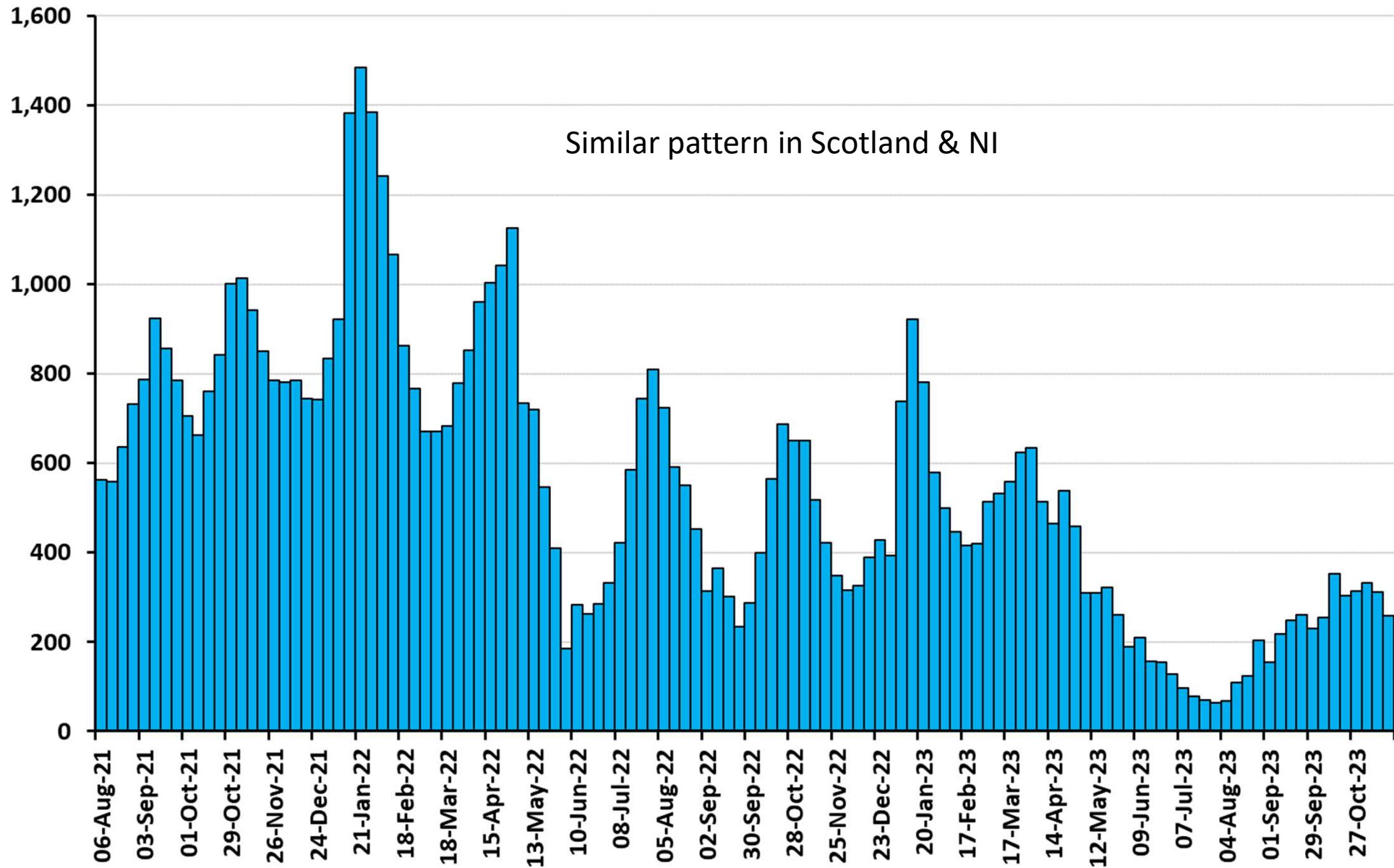

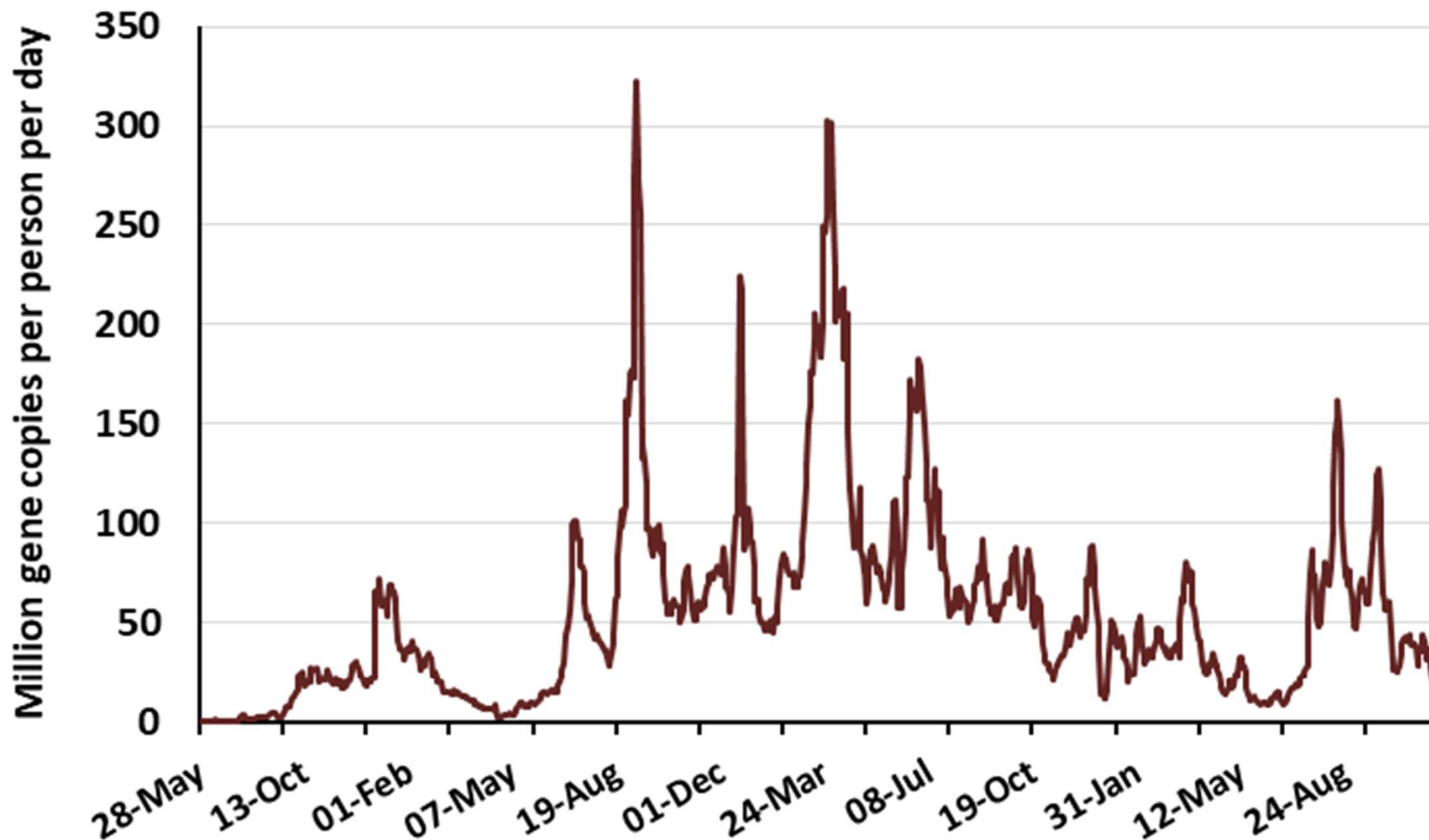

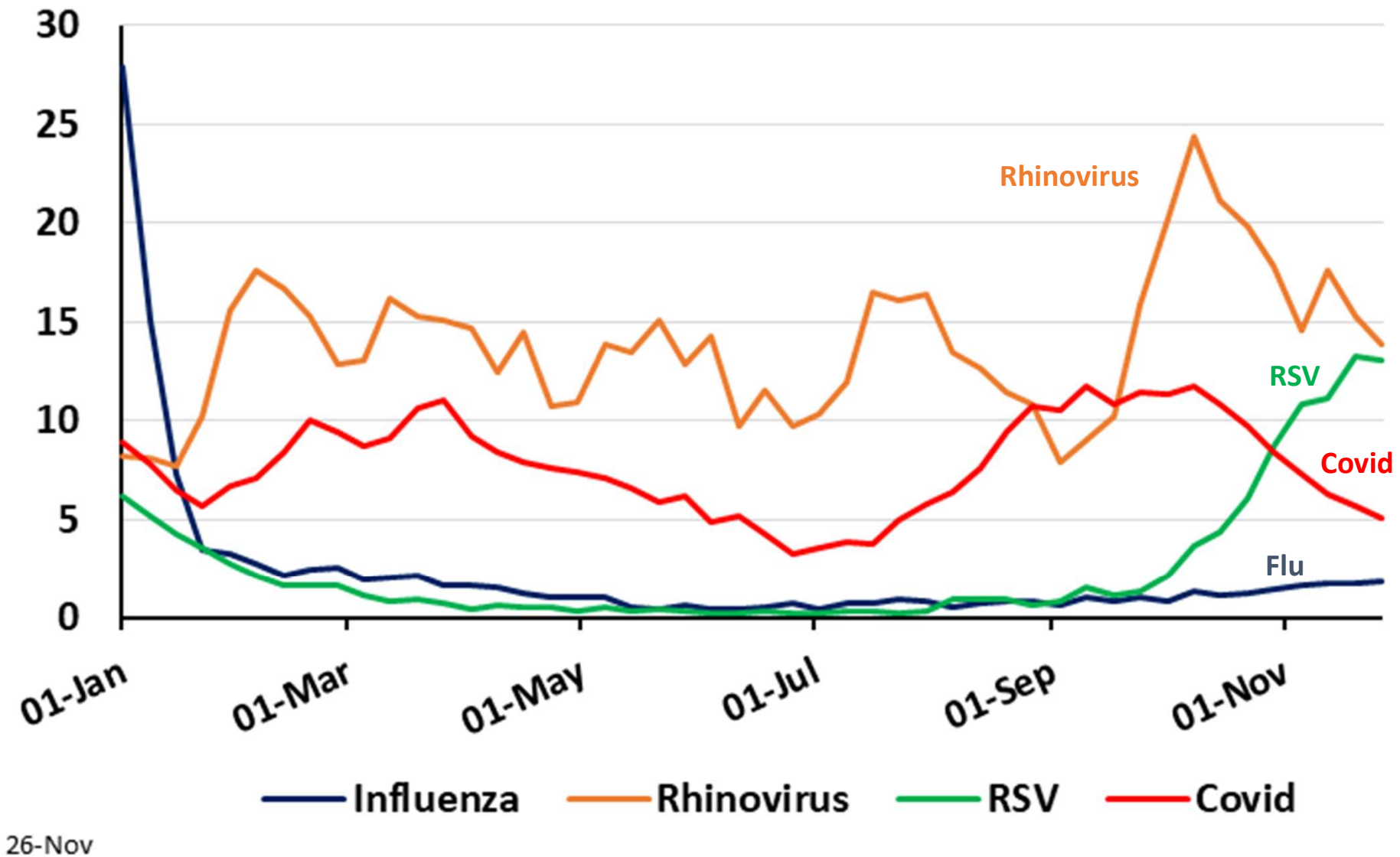

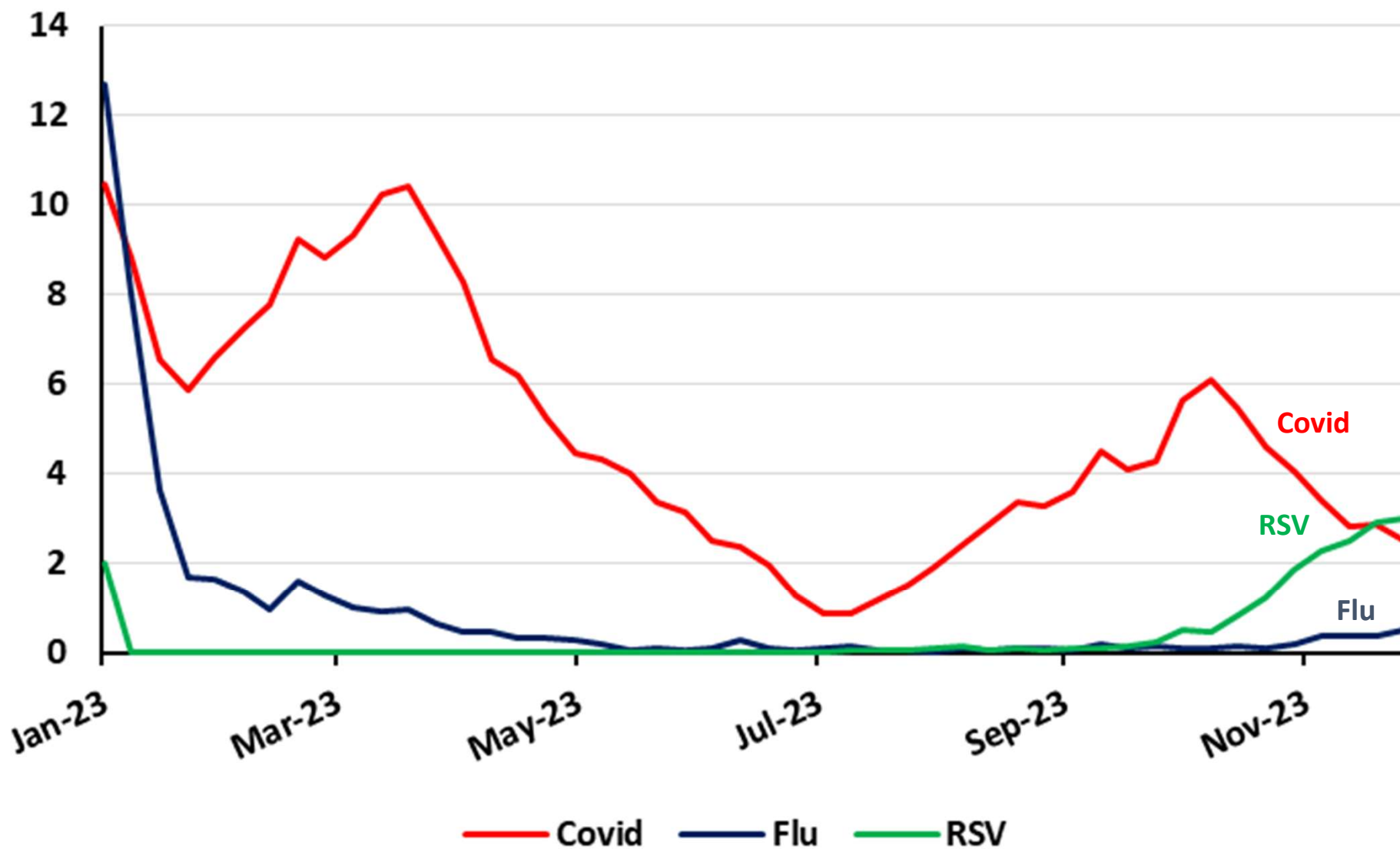

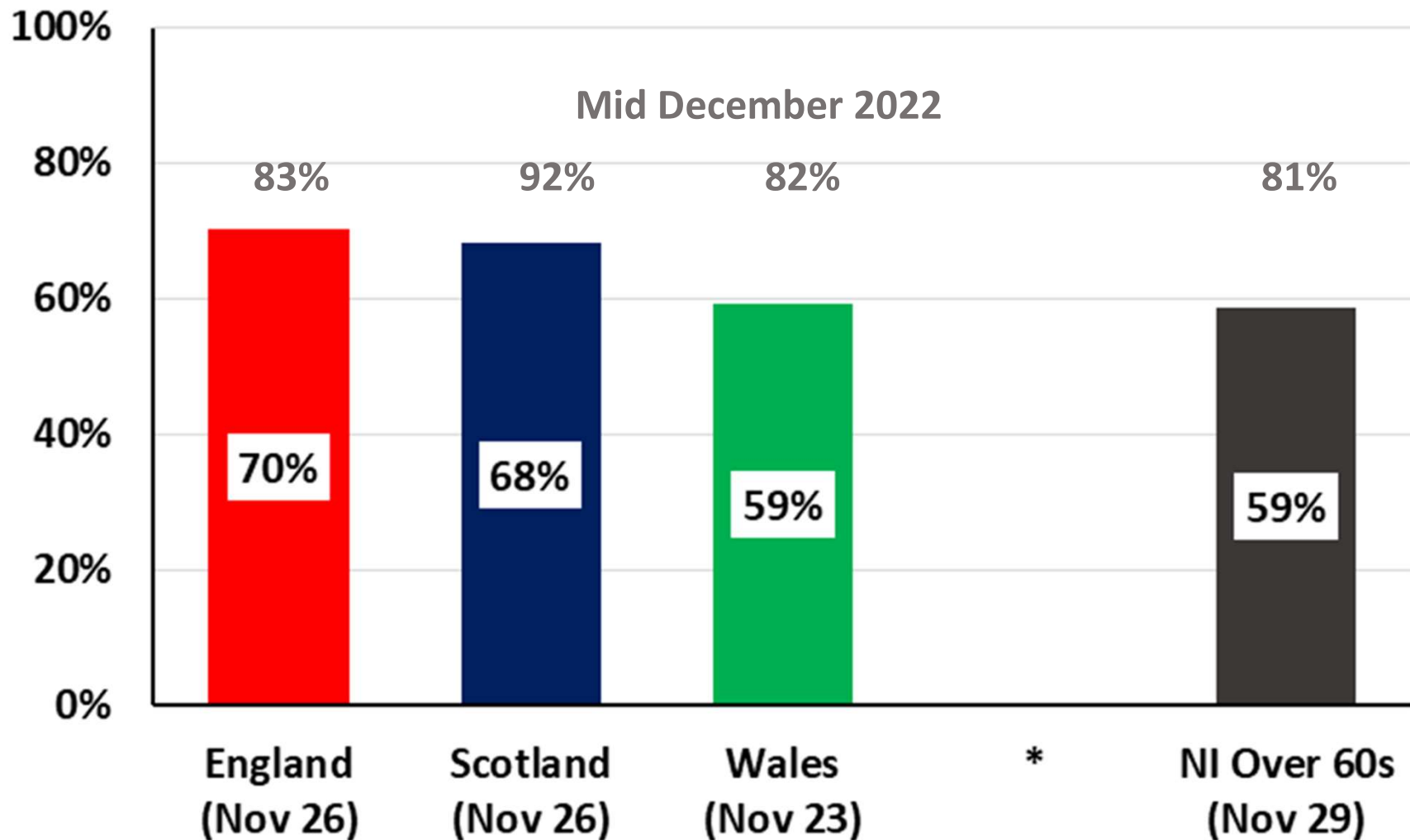

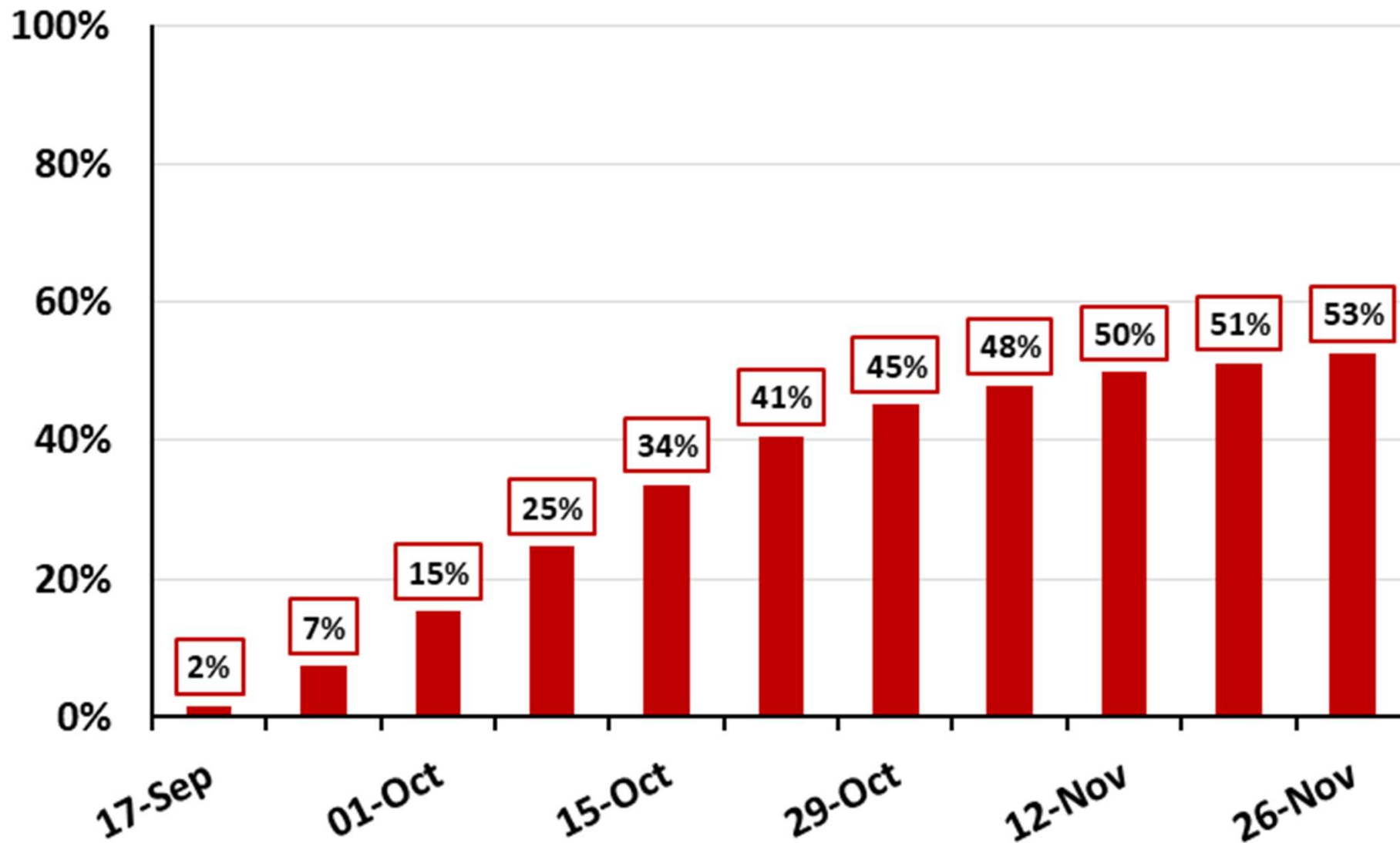

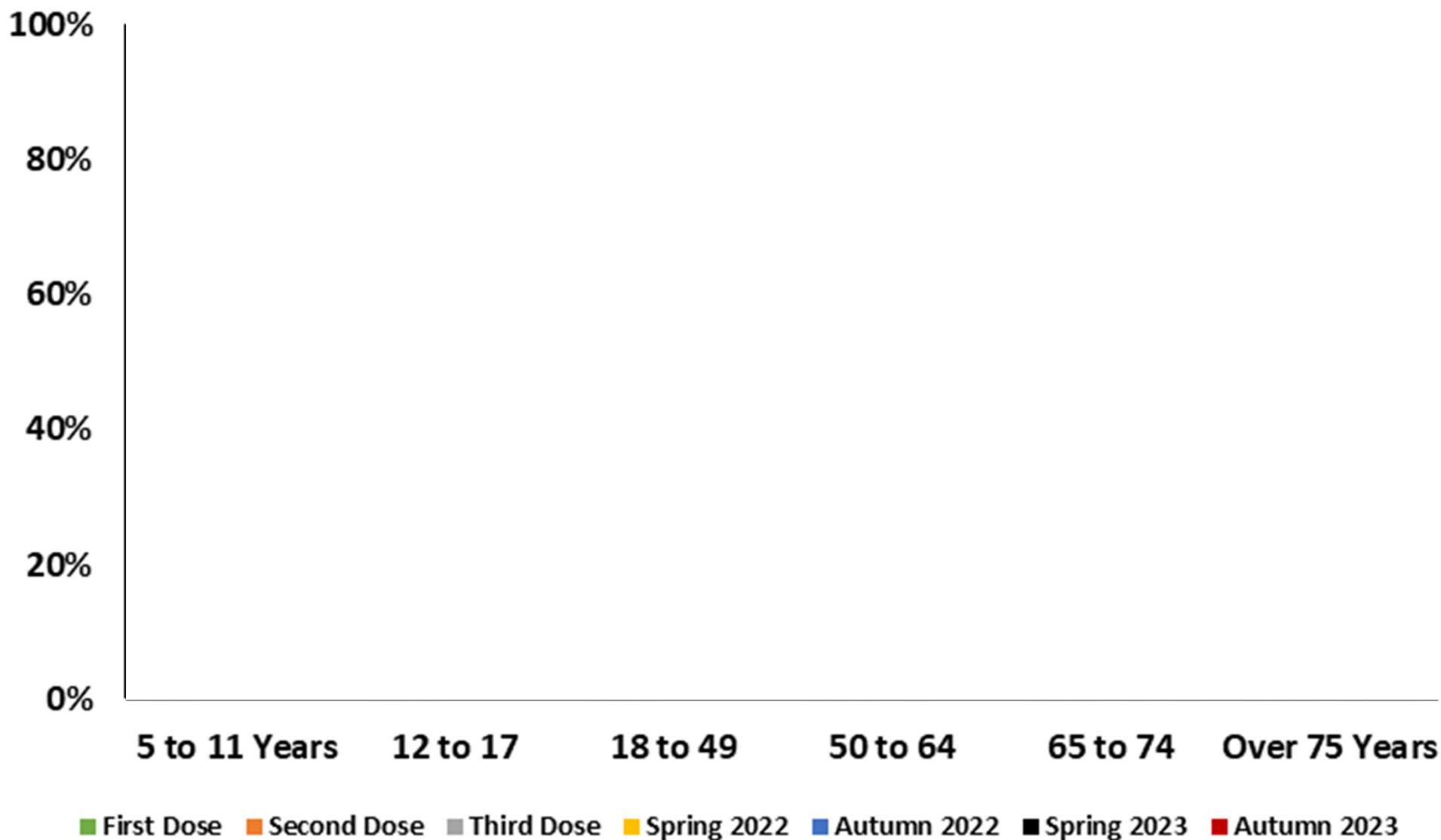


England: Autumn 2023 Estimated Coverage (NHSE)

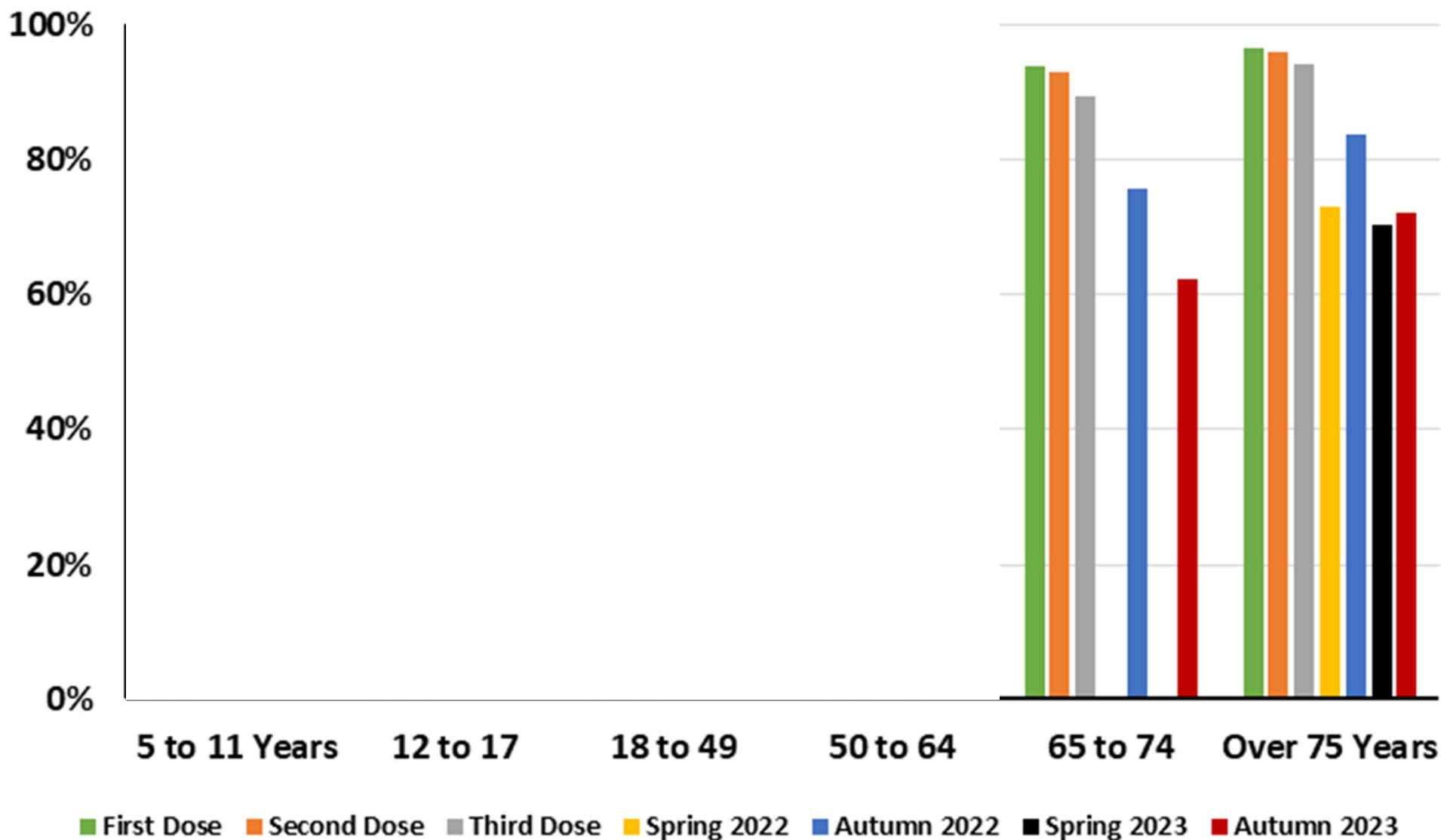


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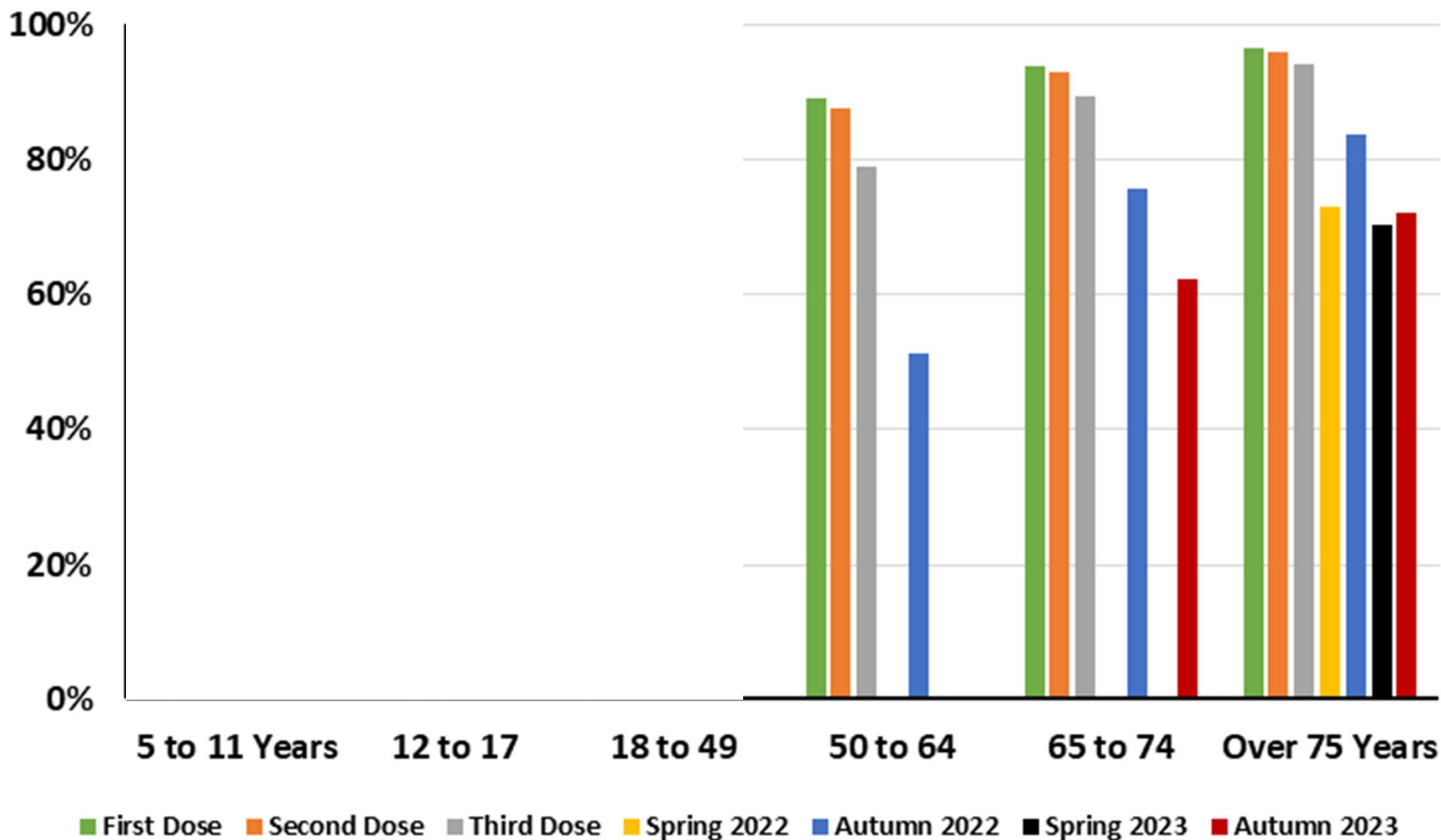


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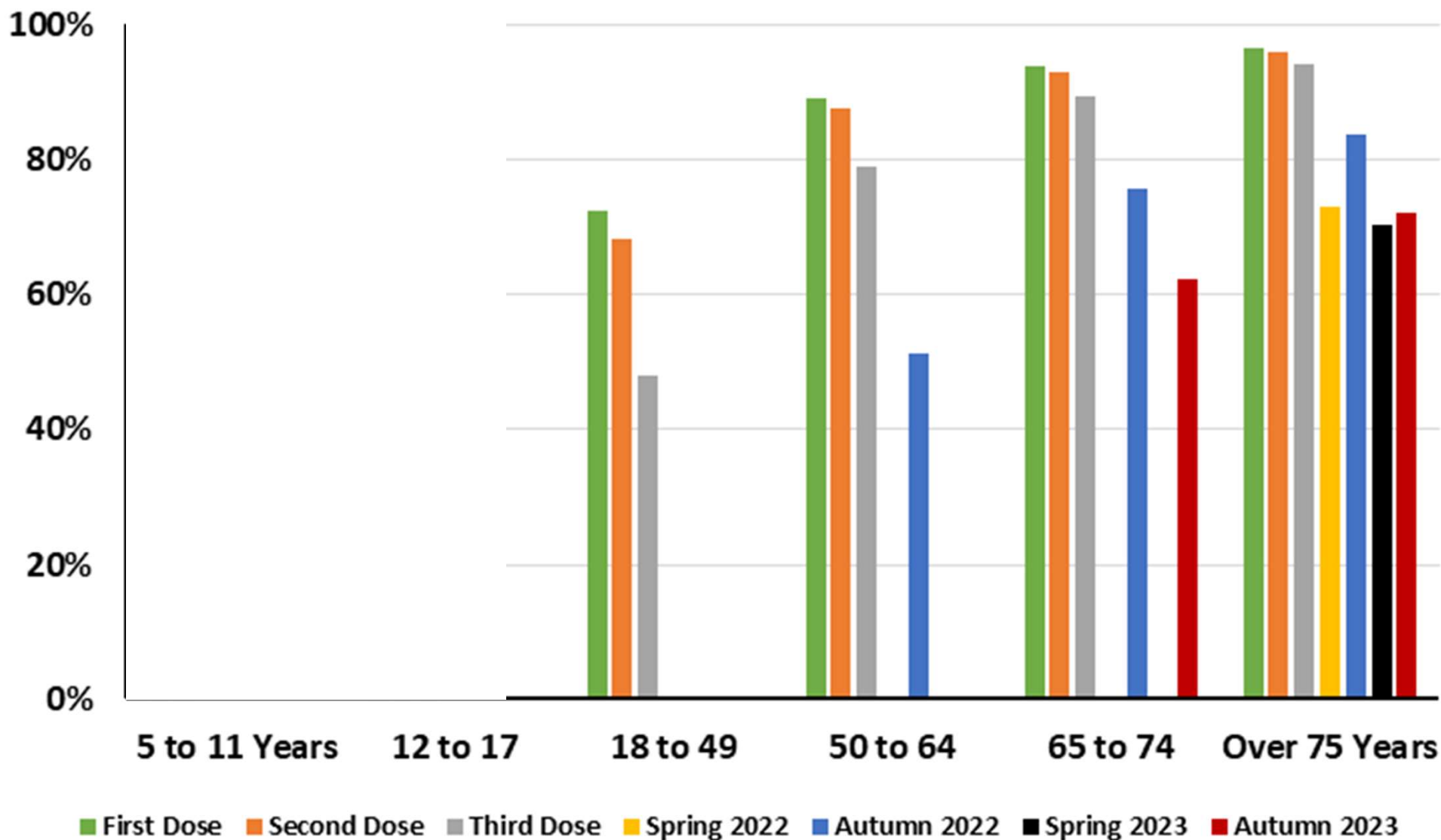


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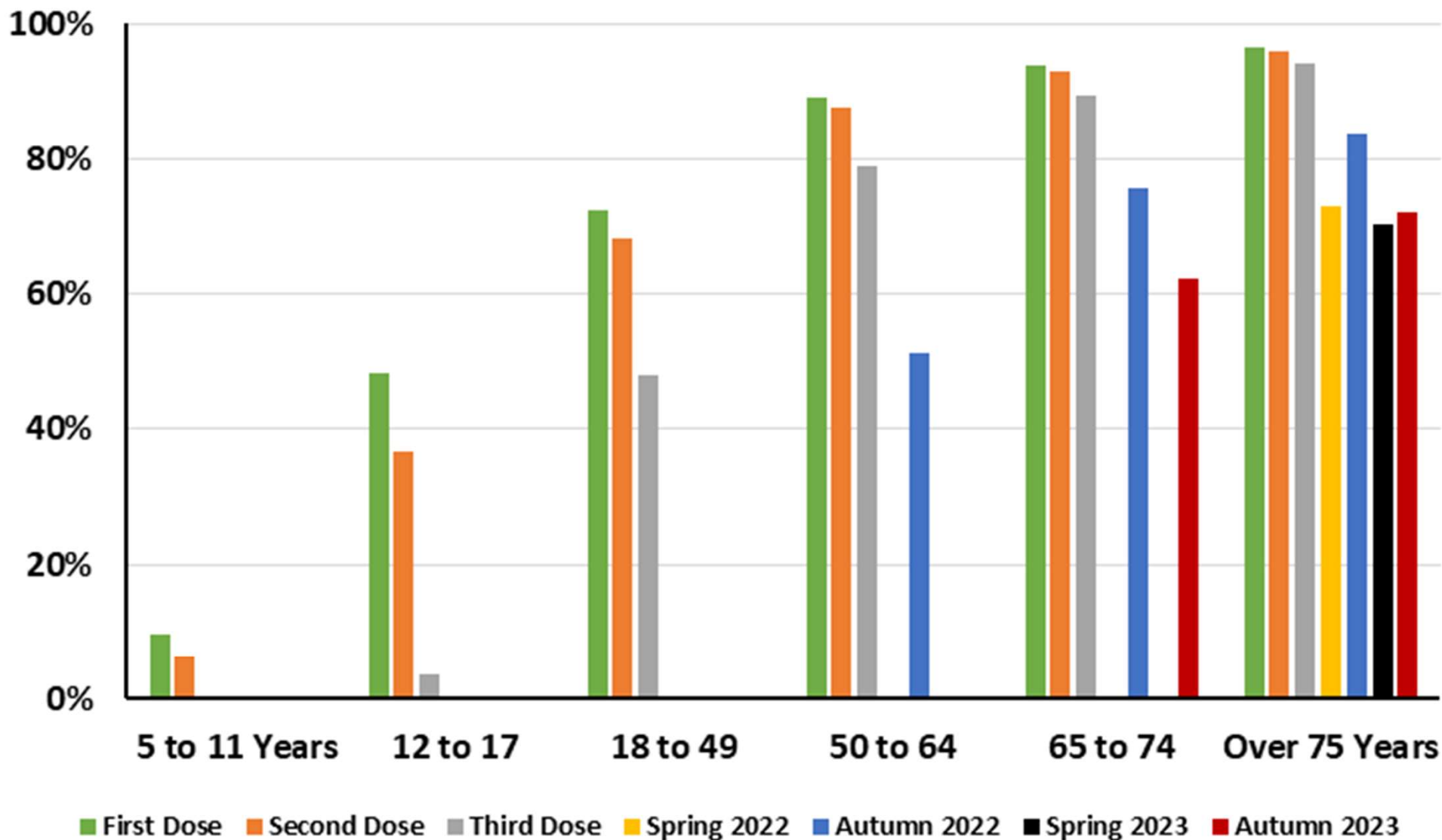


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SUMMARY

- Covid positivity, hospitalisations falling steadily and deaths now falling too. Covid infection survey first results due this month (!) to give a better idea of prevalence.
- RSV rising and hospitalisation rates now higher than Covid. Still plenty of Rhinovirus (causes common cold) around. Hardly any Flu, but it is showing small increase.
- Autumn boosters underway for the over 65s and immunocompromised – drop off in uptake compared to last year and plateauing at about 50% uptake.
